



Iori River Valley Highland Eco-Adventure

One-day Ecotour

Duration: 8 hours (9:00 AM to 5:00 PM)

Description: Immerse yourself in the pristine natural beauty of the Iori River Valley on this one-day ecotour in the highlands of Georgia. Itinerary:

8:30 AM - 9:00 AM: Meet and Greet

1:00 PM - 3:00 PM: Guided Nature Hike and Botanical Walk

Embark on a guided hike through diverse highland landscapes, including forests, meadows, and rocky outcrops, discovering the unique flora of the region.

Learn about the area's ecosystems, local conservation efforts, and the importance of preserving biodiversity.





3:00 PM - 4:00 PM: Cultural Interaction with Local Community

4:00 PM - 4:30 PM: Reflection and Group Photo
